New Business

Quick Books - Leon Thane, Financial Secretary made a motion stating: Ann Helm became the newly elected Treasurer effective July 1, 2022, by vote of the congregation on May 22, 2022. Therefore, effective July 1, 2022, Ann Helm is the new authorized primary administer of our Quick Books Account. Dorothy second the motion. The council approved.

Budget Committee – Ann Helm, Betty Thane, and Pastor Paul will serve on the budget committee. Ann will ask two other members that have experience in budgets to serve as well. Ann will need next year's Core Team budgets by the end of August. The budget committee will meet the first three Wednesdays of September. They will have the new proposed budget ready for presentation at the council meeting October 11.

Steward Consecration Sunday – The council discussed having the Steward Consecration Sunday after Lent in 2023. Pastor Paul will ask the tentative guest preacher if they have any dates available after Lent in 2023. The council will continue this discussion.

Annual Congregational Meeting – The Annual Congregation Meeting will be on Sunday November 63, 2022.

Thanksgiving Meal – The Thanksgiving Meal will be on Sunday November 13, 2022.

Old Business

Maintenance: Harrison Roofing submitted a bid of \$470 to clean all the rain gutters. Council tabled the decision for further review.

Summer Church Picnic and Rally Day – The Church Picnic and Rally Day will be together on Sunday August 21st. Pastor Paul will talk to Heidi about this year's Children's Sunday School.

Tree Trimming - Betty has not received an estimate yet. The council agreed to table the subject.

Mission Endowment Fund – Betty said Joyce O'Connell has agreed to be our contact for information on how to request grant funds from the Mission Endowment Fund.

Constitution Restructure of Council – The council agreed to continue the discussion on this subject.

Communications – Thank you notes from Meals for the Elderly, the Soup Kitchen, and Project Dignidad. The Pregnancy Help Center sent a brochure explaining their services and asking for our help. The Lutheran Immigration & Refuge Services wrote an informative letter also asking for our help. The Lutheran Disaster Relief letter is asking for local congregations to help match a donor's pledge to give \$50,000 if it's matched. Up to \$50,000.

Leon moved to adjourn the meeting. Dorothy second the motion. The council approved. The meeting ended with the Lord's Prayer.




